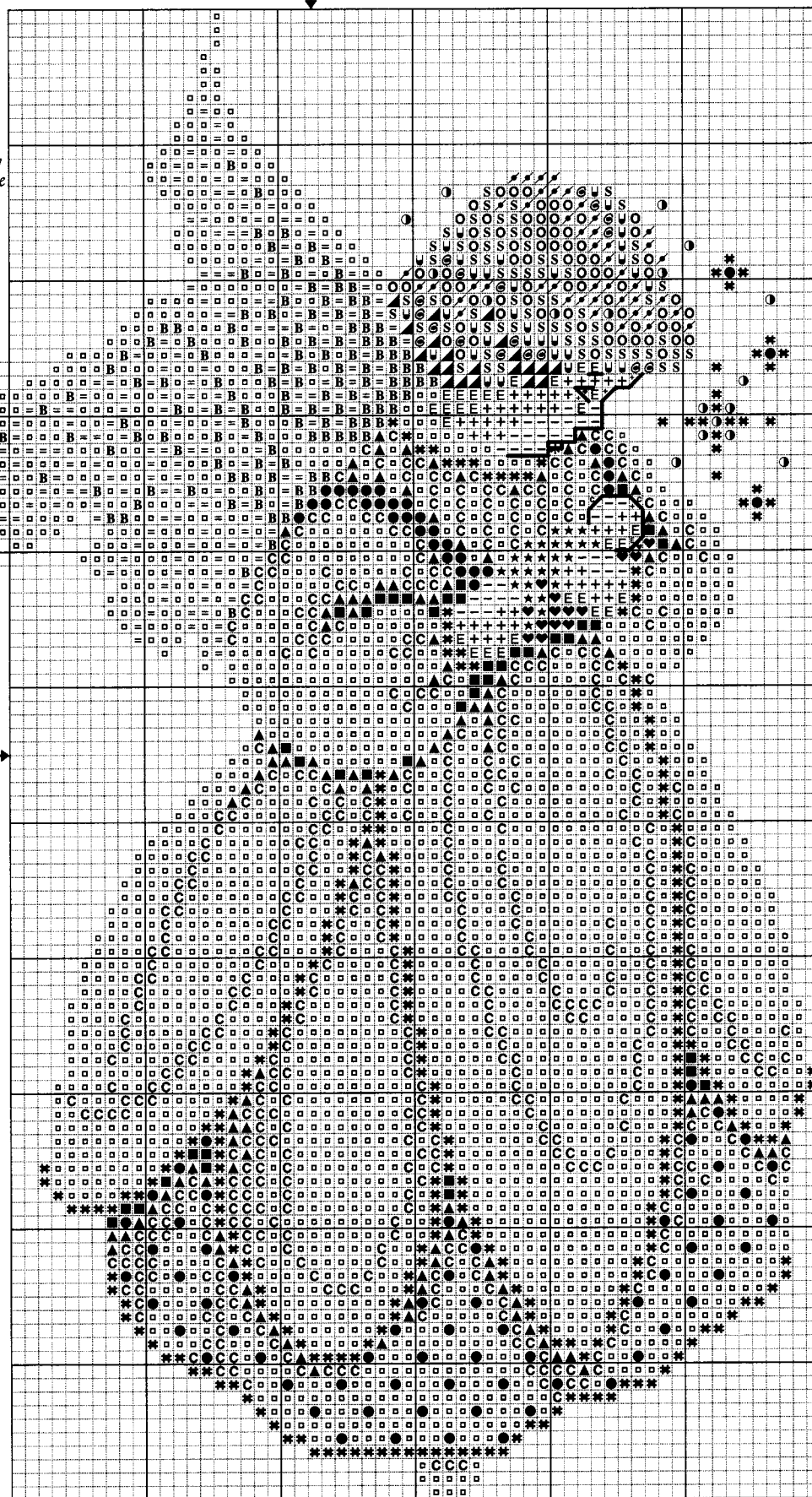
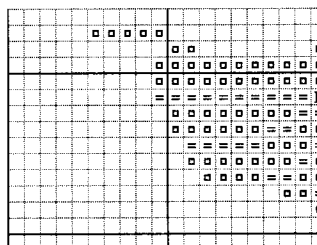


# "2000 Free Angel" from Marilyn Leavitt-Imblum

Stitched on 32 count linen (2 over 2)  
 natural linen from Zweigart.  
 Stitch Count is 75 x 110  
 Design area is 4 7/8" x 7"

We hope that you will use scraps of rainbow, pink or blue or silver metallics and special threads with this little angel. She was especially designed for the Angel Project. This world wide group stitches blankets for Neo-natal babies. Sometimes these blankets are the only thing parents can take home.

She can also be done as a Christmas Angel by making her baby's blanket in gold and her overskirt + bodice in reds and the underskirt + sleeves in greens with gold beads. With a little red shoe peeking out.
