- 2. Remove the mirror by pushing the mirror upward and away from the mounting bracket.
- 3. Installation is the reverse of the removal procedure.


Power Front Seat

- 1. Disconnect the negative battery cable.
- 2. Remove the access covers from the lower shields, if equipped, or insulators, if equipped, to expose the nuts and washers and/or bolts.
- 3. Remove the nuts and washers and/or bolts retaining the seal track to the floorpan.
- 4. Lift the seat up enough to disconnect the seat harness connector and disconnect the connector.
- 5. On certain models, remove the bolt(s) attaching the seat belts to the floor.
- 6. Remove the seat and track assembly from the vehicle.
- 7. Installation is the reverse of the removal procedure.


Rear Seat

> See Figures 70 and 71

 Apply knee pressure to the lower front portion of the rear seat cushion. Push rearward to disengage the seat cushion from the retainer brackets.



- 2. Remove the outer seat belt and seat back lower retaining screws.
- Grasp the seat back at the bottom and lift up to disengage the hanger wire from the retainer brackets.
 - 4. Remove the seat back from the vehicle.



To install:

- Position the seat back into the vehicle so that the hanger wire is engaged with the retaining brackets.
- 6. Install the outer seat belt and seat back lower retainer screws. Tighten to 22–32 ft. lbs. (30–43 Nm)
- 7. Position the seat cushion into the vehicle. Apply knee pressure to the lower portion of the seat cushion, pushing rearward and down to lock the cushion into position.
- 8. Check the rear seat cushion to make sure it is secured into the floor retainer.
