
## **REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION (Continued)**

2. Fold edges of the vinyl toward center and hold so that edges clear end cap slots.

NOTE: Masking tape or a rubber band can be used to secure the vinyl to the LH side of the roller tube.




- While holding vinyl and roller tube, depress RH end cap (marked with an "R" on outside end) approximately 6.35mm (1/4 inch) to disengage clutch. Turn 14 revolutions in direction shown. For reference, wind direction is also marked on the outside end of end cap.
- Release RH end cap. This should engage clutch and prevent loss of spring tension. Unfold vinyl and replace it in end cap slots.
- With vinyl fully retracted, insert luggage cover retainer. Note that RH retainer bracket opening is narrower than LH.
- 6. Check for proper operation of luggage cover.


## **End Cap Replacement, Roll-Up Type**

NOTE: Prior to replacing the end cap on a roll-up type luggage cover assembly, the cover fabric must be fully retracted. This may require an assistant.

1. Position cover assembly on end.



- 2. Depress end cap until roll pin, used to retain end cap to center (metal tube), is exposed. (Maintain pressure through Step 3.)
- 3. Using a 3/32-inch punch, drive out roll pin and remove end cap.



NOTE: Prior to installing replacement cap, make sure there are no burrs on center (metal) tube.
